WHEREAS any and all interested person(s) where heard, and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 51 of 2022 was adopted by the Town of Denning Town Board titled:

Resolution No. 57 of 2022

WHEREAS, New York State Law §113 authorizes the Town Board by Resolution

to transfer surplus monies, contingent appropriations and unexpended fund balances,

AND WHEREAS, the Town of Denning was in need of a budgetary transfer for the 2022 Budget,

AND WHEREAS the Town of Denning Town Board did adopt Resolution No. 38 of 2022 at the Town Board Meeting held on April 12, 2022 for a budgetary transfer in the General Fund,

AND WHEREAS the said transfer of funds delineated in Resolution No. 38 did not take place in a timely fashion and said transfer was not reflected in the Budget vs. Actual Report when reviewed by the Town Board,

AND WHEREAS Resolution No. 48 of 2022 was adopted by the Town of Denning Town Board at its Meeting on August 9th, 2022 to **AGAIN ENACT** said budgetary transfer in the General Fund thereby creating a duplicate budgetary transfer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Denning Town Board **HEREBY RESCINDS Resolution No. 38 of 2022** for budgetary transfer in the General Fund, **THEREBY RESCINDING SAID TRANSFER.**

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Resolution No. 48 of 2022** did, in fact, **ENACT** the adopted and recorded budgetary transfer in the General Fund.

Whereupon, the Resolution was put to a vote, and recorded as follows: Motion to adopt and approve made by Councilman Gregory Vurckio, Seconded by Councilman Paul Schoonmaker.

Supervisor Comments:

- Supervisor Brooks informs those present that he had an in-person meeting with NYS DEC representatives Jeff Rider and Kelly Turturro regarding ongoing issues in the Peekamoose Valley and at the Blue Hole. Supervisor Brooks states that DEC advises it is impossible to close this area. Supervisor Brooks and DEC discussed changing trailer field to parking lot and using the existing bridge abutments on the same side of Peekamoose Road for a walking bridge and trail thus keeping all foot traffic off the road going from the parking lot to Blue Hole. An elevated walkway is proposed to get the foot traffic across the road to the trail down to Blue Hole without impeding traffic. Proposed parking only at the lower field parking area and the trailer field; camping only at lower field; all other parking areas and camping areas closed. Discussion follows.
- ➤ The Sundown Bridge Project is almost done. New Bridge is finished and open! Traffic lights have been removed. The temporary bridge is being dismantled. It is noted that this project has taken approximately 4 months to complete.
- Supervisor Brooks had a phone discussion with Steven Peterson of Ulster County Emergency Management Services regarding beefing up the County Emergency Communication Network. This would open up dead spots in Ulster County, including Denning, for emergency communication outreach equipment. Through phone conversations and meetings, it has been determined that the Frost Valley YMCA property on Red Hill would be the best location; and Jerry Huncosky and the Frost Valley YMCA have been receptive and helpful regarding placement of said emergency communication equipment. Supervisor Brooks states that the Town and County Emergency Management Services System currently located on Red Hill is antiquated. If we lose power the battery does not last long and communications fail after a short time period. The new system will have a generator so it will be active even through major storms and other emergency situations thereby alleviating the current emergency procedure of having to use Sullivan County 911.

> Supervisor Brooks advised that he has a meeting with Titan Well Drillers at Town Hall on Thursday 11/10/22 regarding a filter system for the Town Hall well.

Supervisor Brooks calls for Councilmen Comments:

- Councilman Vurckio informs the Board he will be attending the CWT meeting for November later in the month. October's meeting was cancelled.
- > Councilman Schoonmaker informs the Board that Blue Hole/Peekamoose area tickets are slowing down now that the season is over. Nothing else to report regarding Justice Court.
- Councilman Dean notes that the Ladleton project site on Denning Road still needs road work completed. Highway Superintendent Van Saders reports that the repairs are not Denning's responsibility and will be completed by the project contractor.
- > Councilman Smith has no comments.

Supervisor Brooks calls for any further councilmen comments or discussion. There is none.


