New Business:

Closure on Denning Rd. for 6-8 weeks for bridge replacement between Red Hill Rd. and New Hill Rd. This information needs to be communicated to EMT's, Fire Districts, and Frost Valley.

Dave made Motion to have Minutes emailed to everyone, Tom seconded. None opposed.

Replacement of SCBAs discussed. All tanks will expire in 2024. Andy suggested a staggered replacement over a 3–5-year period.

Members need training on wearing SCBAs.

A grant can be applied for to replace SCBAs; if not approved use Equipment Reserves.

District pays for meals at County meetings.

All are in favor to adopt proposed Budget.

Suggestion from Tom to present a fire extinguisher to be maintained by the Department in lieu of a jacket as a reward for active firefighting. A Motion was made by Andy, Seconded by Dave, None Opposed, to table this idea in order to cost it out. It would be included in next year's Budget.
