## ***Household Garbage:***

This container is for normal household garbage in plastic bags.

## ***Cardboard:***

This container is for Magazines, Clean Unsoiled Paper, Cardboard and Shredded Paper. Please break down all boxes before depositing in the container. Shredded Paper should be in clear plastic bags. No other plastic is allowed in this container.

\*\*\*Pizza boxes and cardboard that is soiled, greasy, oily, wet or dirty does NOT go in this container. Please dispose of these types of items in the Household Garbage container.

## ***Recycling:***

This container is for CLEAN Glass Bottles, Cans, plastic containers and aluminum items. Please remove your recyclables from the bag you brought them in and toss them in the container. There is a garbage can provided for your empty bags nearby.

\*\*\*Flimsy plastic clamshells, Tupperware, empty plastic bags, spackle buckets, Little Tykes Toys, or plastic totes do NOT go in this container. Please dispose of these types of items in the Household Garbage Container.

***If you have any questions or are unsure of where an item goes, please ask Dan.***

***He is HAPPY TO HELP!***

➤ Please refer to the posted schedule regarding charges for truck loads, mattresses, couches, etc. Dan will set the fee for the items you are dropping off. **A check payable to the Town of Denning** is the only accepted payment for this type of charge. Payment is due at time of drop off.

➤ The Town utilizes the ***Metals*** Container which is located on the left of the Transfer Station Garage in the **RED** box. Please deposit your Metal items in this container.

➤ Electronics, refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners are not accepted in Denning. They can be brought to Kingston to UCRRA. Please call them at 845-336-0600 for information and instructions. Dan also has handouts regarding these items.

➤ Used Tires are not accepted at this time. Please let Dan know if this is a need as we are currently doing a survey regarding the possibility of accepting used tires in the future.

➤ **Do NOT toss bags or items into the containers from the ground.** Use the stairways to safely and hygienically dispose of your items. This way there are no messy accidents, nothing gets broken, and there is no risk of injury to yourself or others.

➤ Do not leave Metal during off-hours unless directed by the Highway Superintendent.

➤ **The premises are monitored 24/7 by cameras. Do Not leave anything outside the gate on off-hours.**
